ITEC offers programs to help middle school students stay excited about science, technology, and math, and solve problems, get creative and be part of a team.

Course Descriptions:

Lego Robotics: Using basic concepts of engineering and technology, students learn to build and control their own robots.

Game Design: Logic, art, and storytelling come together as students play and design their own games.

Digital Media: Students work with media artists to create animations, short movies or documentaries, learning how to shoot, edit, and publish their work.

3D Printing: teaches basic 3D modeling, printing and design thinking skills to highlight the importance of creativity in problem solving.

2020 Girls: An all-girls tech club that provides mentorship and builds student confidence and self-esteem. Subject matter differs between 2020 Girls A, B, C and D:

- 2020 A: SCRATCH and Lego Robotics
- 2020 B: Game Design & App Design
- 2020 C: Raspberry Pi & 3D Printing*
- 2020 D: Web Design & Digital Media

*3D Printing offered week of August 1st only.

SCRATCH: Students learn important mathematical and computational ideas, while learning to think creatively, reason systematically, and work collaboratively.

App Design: Students learn the magic behind the apps on their phones and tablets and then have the opportunity to design their own.

Web Design: Combining design and technological skills, students will learn how to arrange and create their own webpage

Raspberry Pi: Students will learn a programming language called Python to program their own Raspberry Pi (a credit card sized computer) that they get to keep!
